# Piece Lodge

### 32" x 50"

This is a free pattern using different elements from the Enchanted Forest pattern. You will need this pattern to make the blocks.

#### **Blocks needed:**

- 1 Morning Sun block
- 1 Left Lodge block
- 1 Middle Lodge block
- 1 Right Lodge block
- 4 Tall Pine blocks

#### **Fabric Requirements**

Background: 1 yd
House ½ yd
Roof, door, and tree trunks ½ yd
Inner border: 3/8 yd
Outer border: ¾ yd

#### Fat Quarters for the following:

- Raindrops
- Sun center
- Sun middle
- Sun outer
- 4 different trees
- House flower border
- House windows
- Heart in door

Binding: ½ yd
Backing: 1 ¾ yd
Batting: 40" x 58"

#### **Cutting to finish this quilt:**

#### **Background:**

• **A** 2-6½" x 12½"

#### Inner border:

- 2 1 ½" x 42 ½"
- 2 1 ½" x 26 ½"

#### **Outer border:**

- 3–3 ½" x WOF strips
- 2 3 ½" x 32 ½"

#### **Binding:**


• 5 − 2 ½" x WOF strips

**Quilt Center:** Stitch **A** to each side of the Morning Star block.

Stitch Left Lodge block, Middle Lodge block, and Right Lodge block.

Stitch the 4 Tall Pine blocks together.

Stitch the Morning Sun segment to the top of the Lodges segment. Stitch the Tall Pines segment to the bottom of the Lodges segment.



Inner border: Stitch 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42  $\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border strips to the sides of quilt center. Press to inner border. Stitch 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26  $\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border strips to the top and bottom of quilt center. Press to inner border.

**Outer border:** Stitch 3 outer border strips, end to end. Trim to  $2-3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $44\frac{1}{2}$ ". Stitch to sides of quilt center. Press to outer border. Stitch  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " outer border strips to top and bottom of quilt center. Press to outer border.

Quilt and bind in your favorite fashion. Enjoy your new quilt!
